





STEPS TO GET A NEW BOTTLE READY FOR USE (PRIMED)

- 1. Before first use, a new bottle must be primed.
 - a. Remove cap (Figure A).
 - b. Shake bottle.
 - Press and release spray nozzle until a fine mist is produced (as shown in Figure B). This may take several times. Take care not to spray in face.





· Repeat steps for priming a bottle (see above).

USE INSTRUCTIONS

- Blow nose gently to clear nostrils.
- Remove cap, then shake bottle.
- 3. Hold bottle with thumb under bottle and spray nozzle between fingers (as shown in Figure B).
- 4. Press against the outside of your nose with your finger to close off one nostril (as shown in Figure C).
- 5. Place the tip of the spray nozzle into the other nostril. The spray nozzle should not reach far into the nose. Aim nozzle toward back of nose (as shown in Figure C).

6. While sniffing gently, spray into nostril

- 7. Repeat steps "4" through "6" for the other nostril.
- 8. After using the nasal spray, wipe nozzle with a tissue and replace cap by pressing it down over the spray nozzle.

- 2. Rinse SPRAY NOZZLE ONLY under warm water (as shown in Figure G).
- 3. Shake or tap to remove excess water.
- 4. Re-attach spray nozzle to bottle.
- 5. Press and release spray nozzle until a fine spray is produced, taking care not to spray in face.
